We are looking for a UI/UX Designer to temporarily support the integration of the LICCI and CONECT-e projects into a progressive web-app (2-3 months starting immediately; ***job to be completed by mid-October***).

LICCI – Local Indicators of Climate Change Impacts: the contribution of local knowledge to climate change research (www.licci.eu) – is a project aiming to bring indigenous and local knowledge to climate change research by allowing any citizen in the world to contribute information on local indicators of climate change impacts and any researcher working on these issues to collaborate and create networks with other researchers and citizens.

CONECT-e - compartiendo el CONocimiento ECológico Tradicional (www.conecte.es) is a citizen science wiki-like platform devoted to the documentation and sharing of Traditional Ecological Knowledge (TEK) related to biodiversity in Spain. The platform has already collected some data and would like to expand by building a progressive web-app.

The UI/UX Designer will join our CTO and support him in the development of core features of the platform and prototyping features that interface earth observation data (satellite) using machine learning techniques. The work will be conducted partly at the ICTA - UAB (Barcelona) and remote.

The UI/UX Designer help us shape the user interface of the progressive web-app, which will be used by participants all around the world. The requirements for the backend developer are:

- Strong UI/UX skills and tools
- HTML and CSS skills are very favorable
- Experience with user interfaces including maps are favorable
- Good oral and written English skills are favorable
